You can read about this in Acts Chapter 8. Verses 26-31



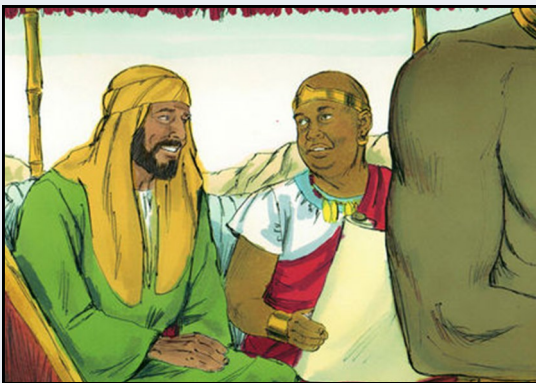
An angel of the Lord told Philip to go to a place where he would find the Ethiopian Man returning home from Jerusalem.

Philip asked “Do you understand what you are reading?”

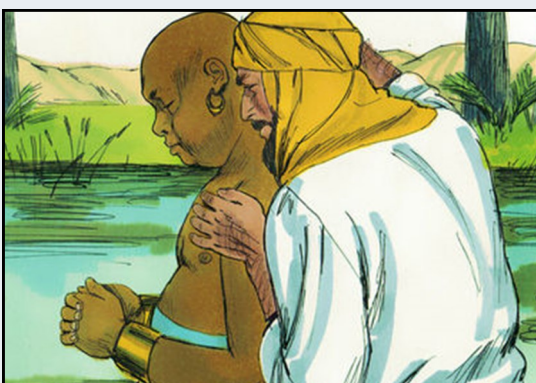
“How can I, unless someone explains it to me?”
